# 19-1-1 <u>Definitions</u>

Terms used herein shall be as defined under State law governing fireworks.

# 19-1-2 <u>License Required for Sale</u>

No person shall sell at retail within the Town any type of fireworks until he has obtained a permit therefore from the Board of Trustees. Said permit shall be issued only for sale to such persons, organizations or government entities as are permitted by State law to conduct public fireworks displays or for sales for shipment out of State pursuant to State law. No permit will be issued unless the Board of Trustees is satisfied that the applicant and its .Officers, if any, are of good moral character and reputation and that the applicant has no plan, intent or scheme to make prohibited sales of fireworks.

# 19-1-3 <u>Duration of License; Fee</u>

The license issued by the Board of Trustees shall be valid for a period of twelve months from its issuance and a fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00) will be payable upon issuance or renewal of same.

#### FIREWORKS General Provisions

## 19-1-4 Permit Required for Displays of Fireworks

No person shall use or display any fireworks within the Town limits without first obtaining a permit therefore and posting a bond as described in Section 19-1-6.

## 19-1-5 Permit for Display or use of Fireworks

Application for a permit to display or use fireworks Within the Town may be made by any fair association, amusement park or other organization or groups in writing and at least fifteen (15) days before the event of use or display. Said permit shall be issued after an investigation by the Fire Department and upon favorable recommendation thereby that such use or display will not be hazardous to a person or property and that the fireworks will be handled by a competent person.

### 19-1-6 <u>Bond</u>

A performance bond shall be required from each permittee yin, a sum not less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) conditioned upon compliance with State law, regulations of the Secretary of State and this Article.

# 19-1-7 <u>Disposal of Fireworks</u>

The Fire Department of the Town shall after the conclusion of any permitted display or use immediately dispose of all unfired fireworks.

# 19-1-8 <u>Seizure of Fireworks</u>

The Police Department of the Town shall seize, take and remove, at the expense of the owner, all stocks of fireworks

offered or exposed for sale, stored or held in violation of state law or this Article.
